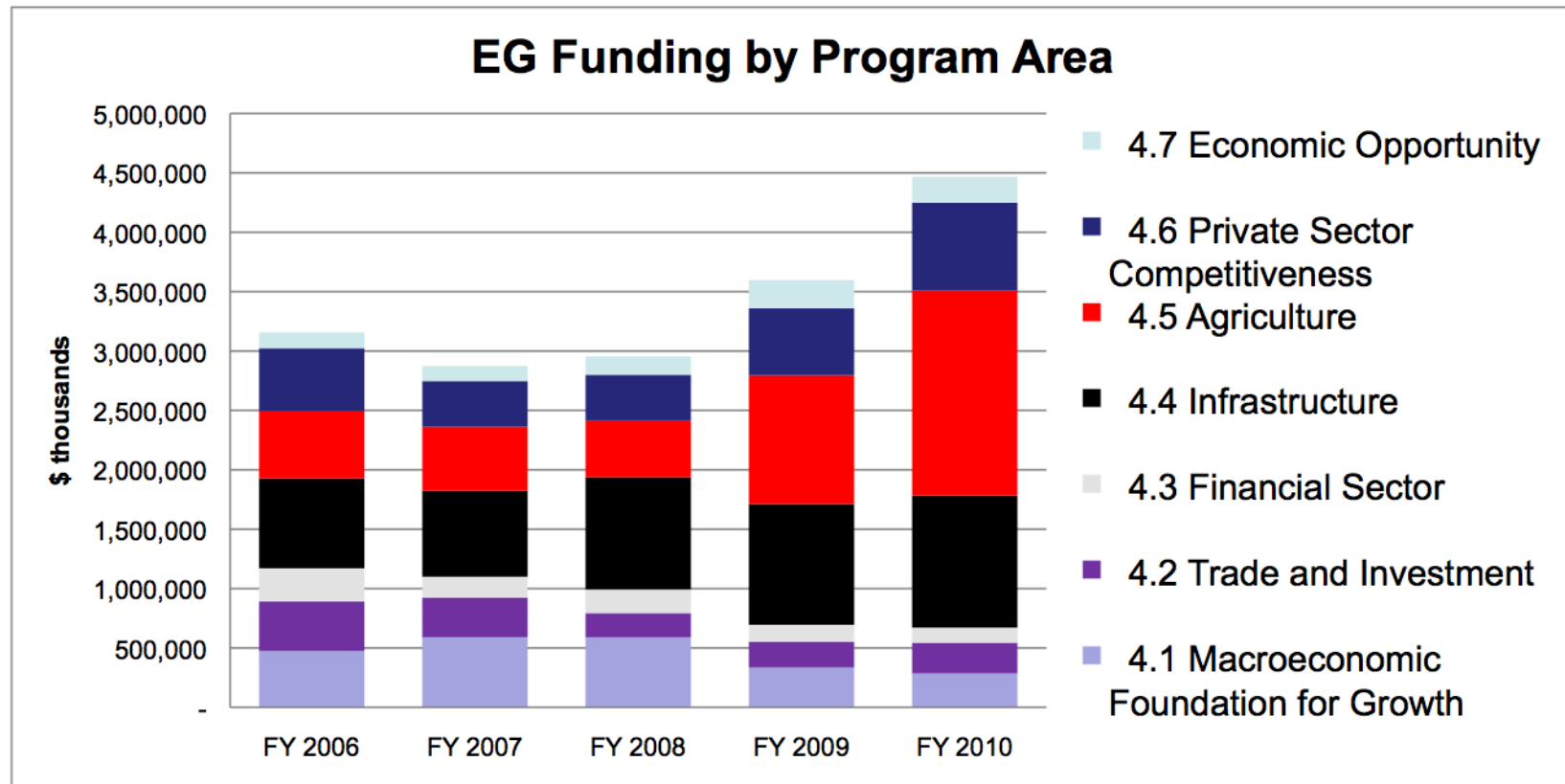

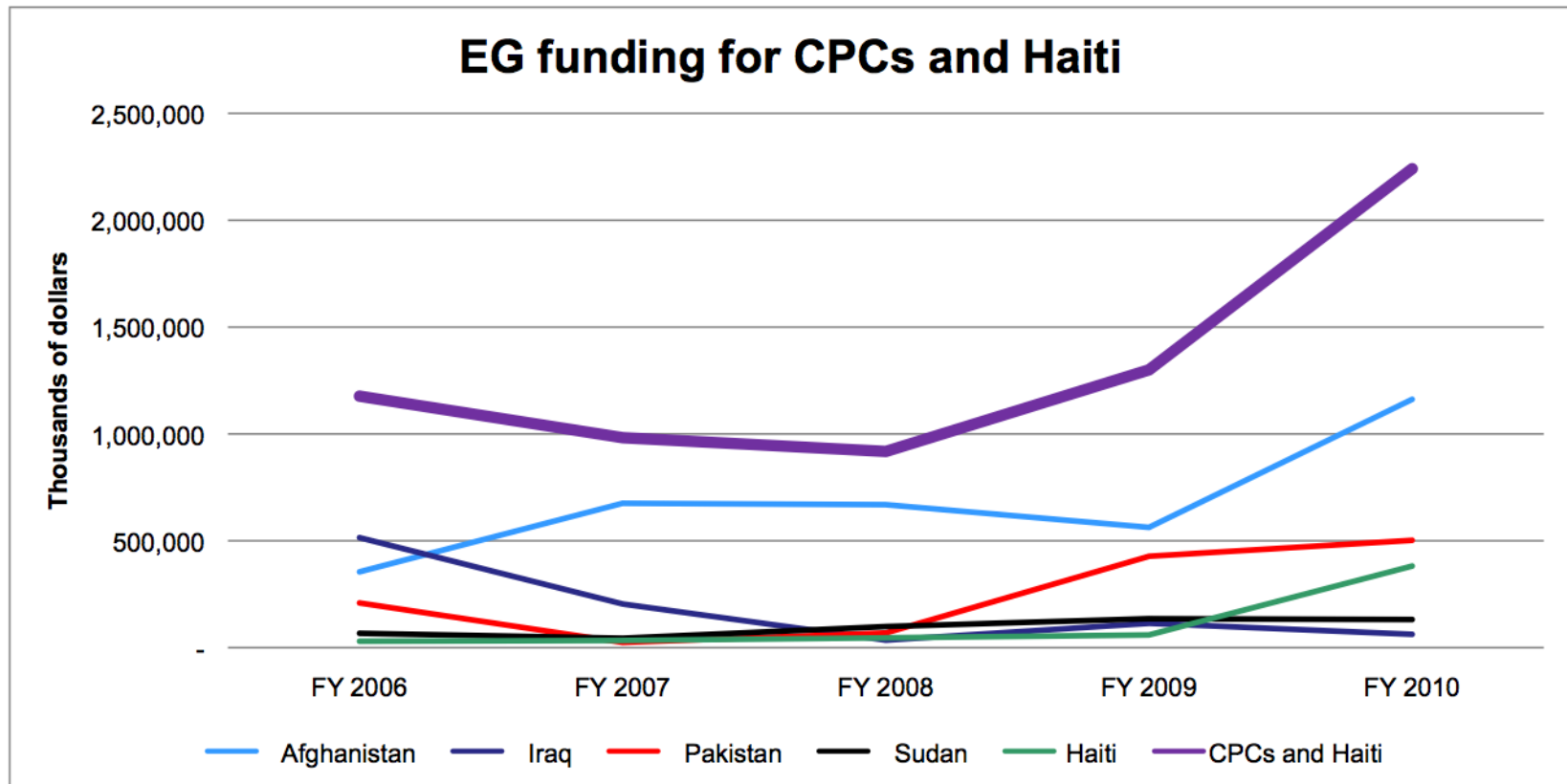

 - Judicial complexes
 - Irrigation
 - Other public buildings
 - Other infrastructure services

How Does Infrastructure Affect Development?

- Economic Growth = $f(K, L, T, P, O)$

Where:

K = Built Capital, Machinery, and Equipment

L = Labor (Quantity and Quality)

T = Technology (Science, Information, and Knowledge)

P = Policies, Laws, Regulations, etc.

O = Organizational Capacity, Responsibilities, and Accountability

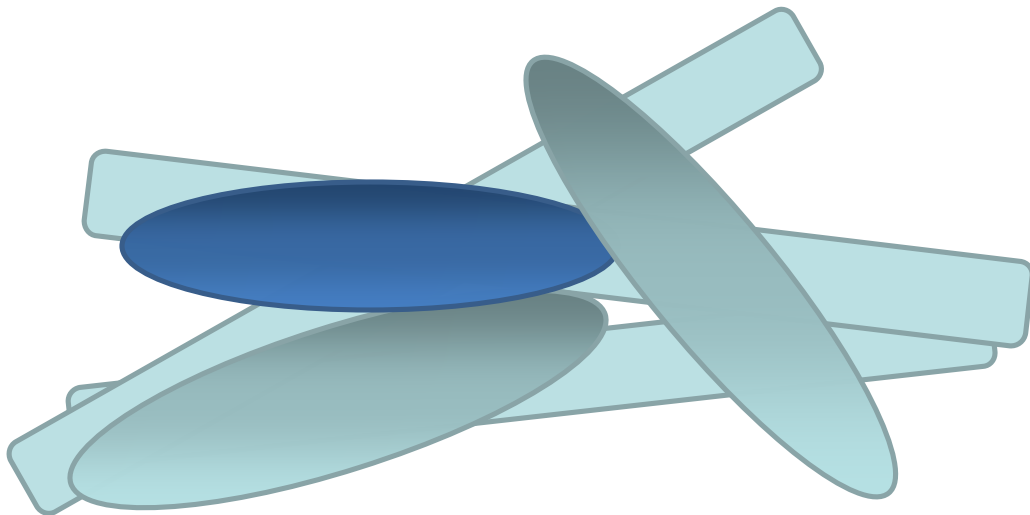

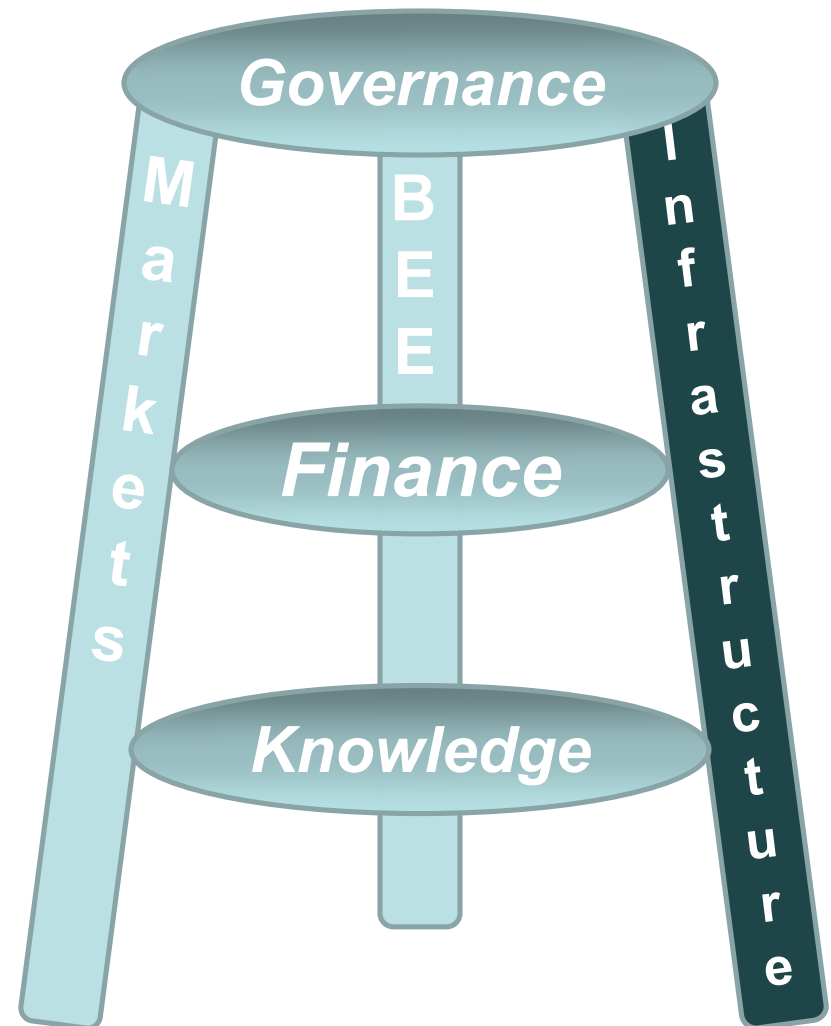

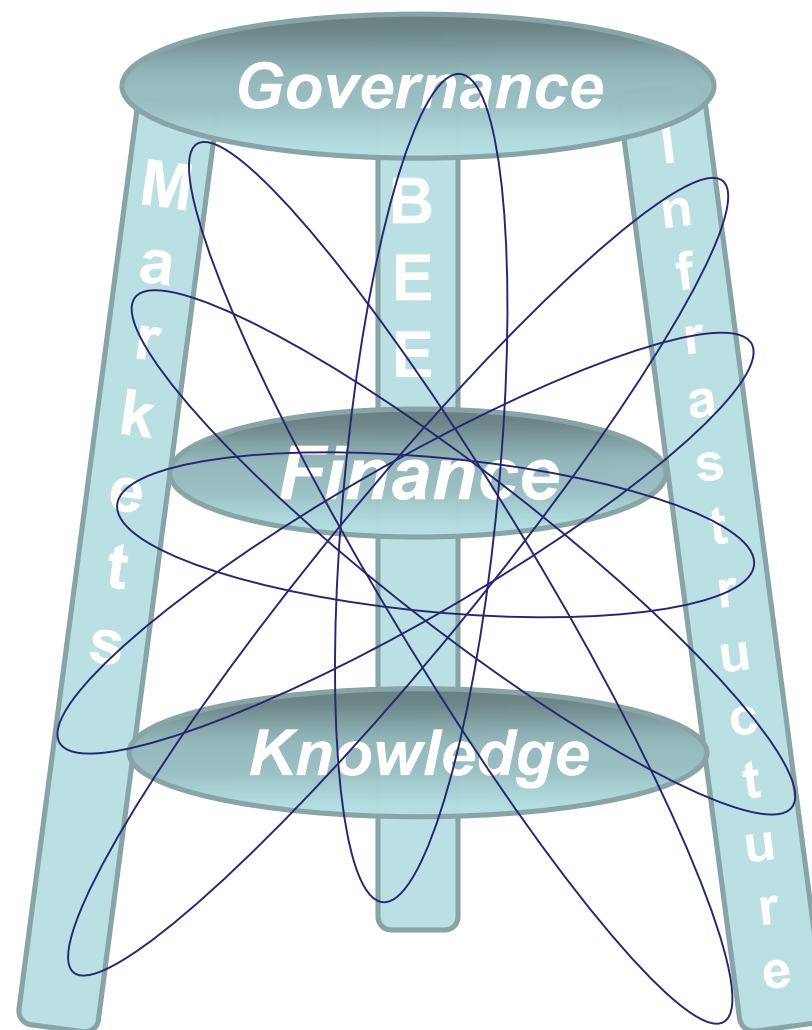
